In terms of delivering aid, it has been one of the most productive years for us, as the years of planning to minimise costs and building effective delivery systems are showing great results on the ground.

For the past four years, one of our main aims has been staying transparent with donors about the money that is donated, which reaches end users quickly and efficiently through aid and support.

We have improved our feedback mechanism for all our projects.

On the ground, it has been another challenging year, particularly in Gaza, where delivering aid has sometimes been almost impossible.

Our partners on the ground have gone through unimaginable harm.

Despite all of these challenges in Gaza, we were able to reach over 113,000 people in the wartorn Strip. Our programmes in the region continue to provide food, medical aid and psychological support to children and women who have PTSD.

We also supported people dealing with natural and manmade emergencies from West Africa, Sudan, and South Asia. We also provided thousands of people with clean drinking water, education for underprivileged children, and livelihood programmes for farmers and urban daily wage workers.

This impact report talks about our impact in various in more detail. It is a testimony of your faith in our work, and we can't thank you enough for your support.

Despite the ceasefire, the situation in Gaza is a humanitarian tragedy where people continue to suffer. Civilian infrastructure has been almost destroyed, while 96% of people don't have enough food.

Lack of clean water, almost no healthcare, and large-scale displacement have made Gaza a

- 1,200 people were provided with winter clothing.
- 3,000 families were provided with month-long supplies of baby food and nappies.

NIGER EMERGENCY

About Niger

Even before the ongoing political crisis, Niger remained one of the poorest countries in the world. It is a landlocked country in the Sahel region with a population of over 25.3 million people.

All of these factors are worsening with the growing insecurity in the region, mismanagement of natural resources, environmental degradation, rapid growth in the population, inherent gender inequalities and climate change.

Food Crisis in Mali

According to the latest report from the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF) close to five million children are in urgent need of humanitarian assistance in Mali, including health, nutrition, education, and protection services - as well as access to safe water. The number shows an increase of at least 1.5 million children in need since 2020.

This developing situation is due to protracted armed conflict, internal displacement, and restricted humanitarian access risks pushing nearly one million children under the age of 5 in Mali into acute malnutrition by December 2023 – with at least 200,000 at risk of dying of hunger if life-saving aid fails to reach them.

What is Muntada Aid Doing in Mali?

Protecting children and women from violence, abuse, and exploitation requires a comprehensive child protection system that addresses the full spectrum of risks they face.

Children and young people in Mali, and especially girls, continue to bear the brunt of the country's complex and protracted crisis, risking their lives, losing their homes, being abducted and recruited by armed groups, separated from families, and exposed to sexual and gender-based violence.

Muntada Aid is providing multi-level support to refugees, children and young women in Mali.

ABOUT SUDAN ENERGENICY

There are over 10.7 million people uprooted from their homes in Sudan, including 9 million displaced internally-two-thirds since the conflict broke out in April 2023. Sudan now has the highest rate of internal displacement in the world, even surpassing Syria's 7.2 million.

As people continue to flee the conflict in Sudan, more than 358,000 refugees have arrived at the border town Adré, in eastern Chad. Refugee camps are being built, but the shelter and basic facilities available in the camps are wholly inadequate to meet the needs of the incoming people.

What is Muntada Aid Doing?

Muntada Aid supports over 21,00 refugees living at the border town Adré in eastern Chad with monthly food packs. But we need to reach more families. Your donation will help us deliver more emergency food aid.

GIFT OF SIGHT

About Cataract Blindness in Africa

An estimated 5 million people are blinded by cataracts each year. Blindness affects more than 4% of the population in parts of sub-Saharan Africa.

In Sub-Saharan Africa, the most recent estimate of the burden of visual impairment indicates that 21.4 million people are visually impaired, including 4.8 million people who are blind. Despite cost-effective solutions, such as cataract removal and the provision of eyeglasses, an extremely high proportion, estimated at 2/3, of these cases of vision impairment could have been prevented or treated.

It is estimated that regionally, just three ophthalmologists per million population are available in Sub-Saharan Africa.

LITTLE HEARTS **About Little Hearts**

Our little hearts project provides free life-saving heart surgeries to babies and children with Congenital Heart Defects from underprivileged families irrespective of gender, race and religion.

In poor underdeveloped countries, the lack of specialized medical infrastructure means babies born with congenital heart defects have little or no access to necessary treatment.

Muntada Aid believes ignoring this deadly killer is tantamount to a death sentence for the many children born with this disease. Most of these conditions can be fixed, but children suffer due to a lack of resources, infrastructure, and specialist medical staff.

We are committed to children with CHD and provide them with an opportunity for a healthy life.

Little Hearts is Muntada Aid's flagship project and was launched in April 2012.

MUNTADA AID PERFORMS FIRST OF ITS KIND HEART OPERATION ON 9-DAY OLD CHILD IN TANZANIA

Last year, our team was able to carry out the first of its nature heart intervention on a 9-day-old child in Tanzania.

Our Little Hearts project provides free life-saving heart surgeries to babies and children with Congenital Heart Defects from underprivileged families, irrespective of gender, race or religion.

An estimated **1.5 million** children each year are born with a congenital heart defect globally. **10% of babies born** with CHD do not survive their first year of life. **1,000s** more die and don't reach adulthood.

How You Can Support

It costs thousands of pounds worldwide to carry out these procedures and surgeries. In Africa, there is very little infrastructure and manpower available to children who desperately need support.

We provide these procedures free to children from the point of contact. A small donation from you will allow us to continue providing these life-transforming interventions.

MUNTADA AID IN PAKISTAN

HIJRAH RIDE – A JOURNEY LIKE NO OTHER

Hijrah Ride is a flagship partnership between Muntada Aid & H&KCC. This annual cycling event is a 3-day long marathon where riders from various parts of the UK cycle from Mecca to Madinah, covering a distance of over 550 kilometres between the two of Islam's holiest of mosques.

The journey symbolises the migration that Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) took as he fled persecution in Mecca and travelled to Madinah for safety.

Muntada Aid's livelihoods programme is to empower women and communities by providing them with training and resources to build lives within their local ecosystems.

What Do We Do?

We invest in small scale farmers and women in Africa.

Goat Rearing

Initially, Muntada Aid provide five animals (goats) to farmers in rural communities in Niger. Besides receiving the animals, farmers also acquire basic training to look after goats. We quarterly check on families to see how they are doing and how we can further help their economic situation if needed.

Seamstress Training

We are providing six-month long training in tailoring to women in Niger. At the start of the training we provide women with sewing machines to help them train and establish their business.

Motorised 3-wheelers for commercial cargo

Muntada Aid is providing motorised 3-wheelers cargo vehicles to help disadvantaged families in urban towns in Niger and Mali. The scheme, which was launched in 2024 is has been a real success story. The families that have received these vehicles have seen their economic fortunes change as the average income for each family have seen an increase between £200-£300 per month, which is huge in these countries where average income can be just £100 per month.
